This is a so-called 'defective' verb. These verbs have the peculiarity that the only forms allowed are those whose ending begins with **i**. There is only one other defective verb in common use, **agredir** to assault, although **garantir** is sometimes still used in Latin America for **garantizar** to guarantee. There is a tendency nowadays also to use forms of these verbs whose ending begins with **e**, e.g. **abole** he abolishes.

The other verbs of this type listed in this book are virtually unused nowadays, only their past participle being found (e.g. **aguerrido** battle-hardened).
