

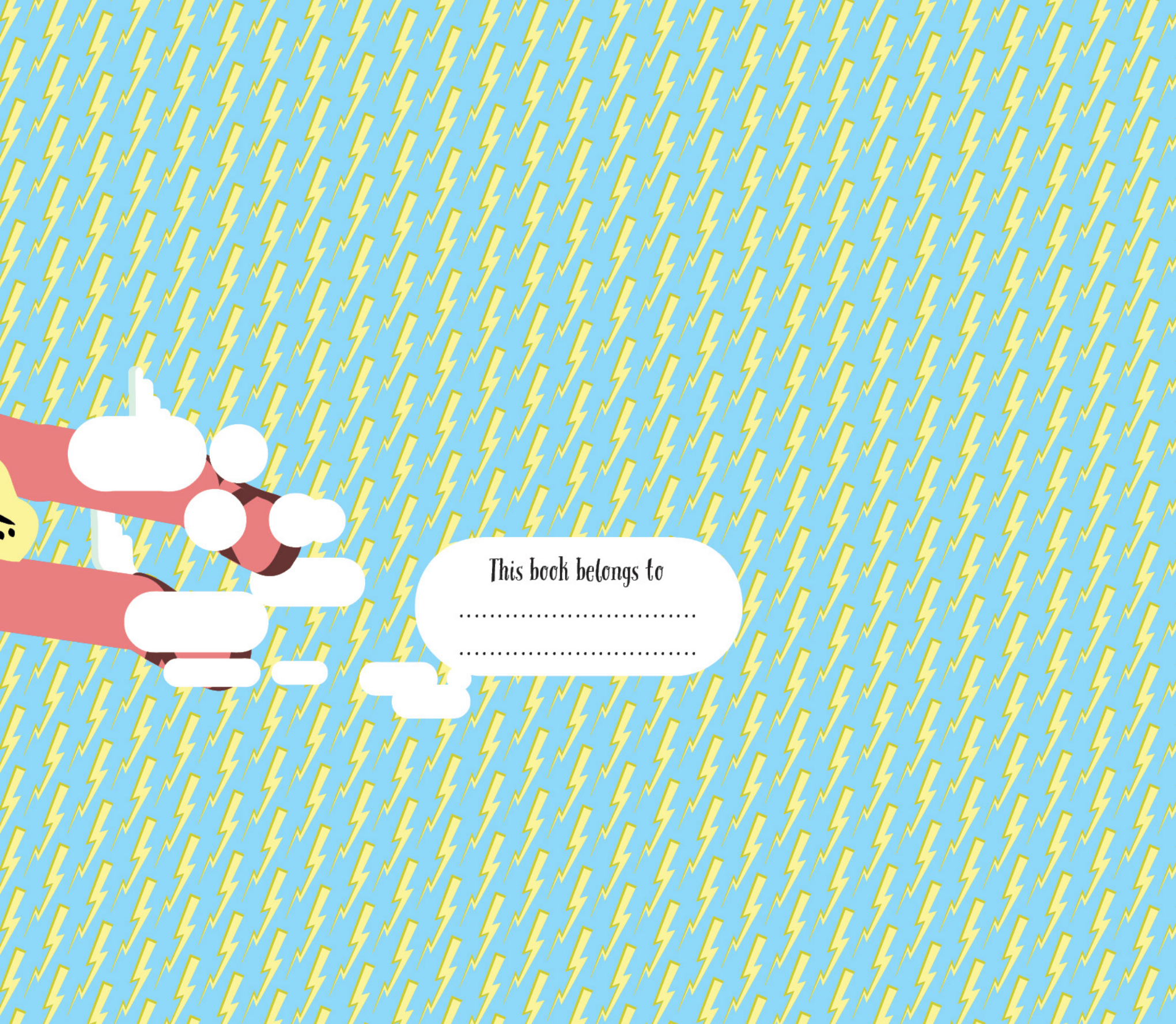

I hold a trident, not a fork.

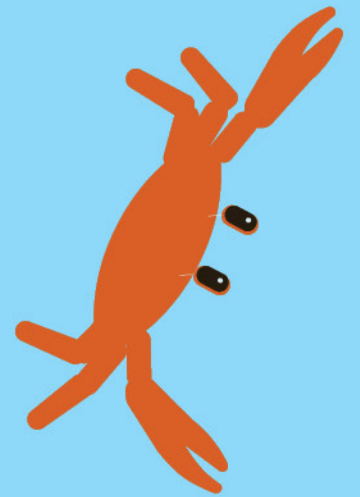
I have a long beard
